

The Student Contract for distance learners – addendum for standalone credit bearing modules

This Addendum is in addition to the Student Contract for Distance Learners (<https://www.exeter.ac.uk/students/administration/studentcontract/>) and applies to those registered students who are enrolled on a standalone credit bearing module (as opposed to a programme) and such module is designed to be delivered fully online to “Distance Learners”.

Where a Distance Learner is enrolled on a standalone credit bearing module, the Student Contract for Distance Learners will still apply to you, but the following sections will also apply and will replace some of the wording in the Student Contract for Distance Learners where it is different:

1. **Terminology:** References to “*programme*” shall mean “*programme or module*” in applicable parts of the Student Contract for Distance Learners.
2. **Services and benefits:** You will have access to all of the services and benefits set out in the Student Contract for Distance Learners, but you acknowledge that some of these will have limited scope due to the short-term nature of studying a standalone module (for example, you technically have the right to join sports clubs as part of the Athletic Union, but membership will only last for the length of time you are an enrolled student, so there may not be a practical, cost-effective or realistic membership option that works for you).
3. **Cooling Off Period and Right to Withdraw:**
 - a. You are entitled to a 14 day cooling off period for each standalone module that you register for separately. If you register for another standalone module in the future, you will be entitled to a 14 day cooling off period for that new module. Please read section 3.6 of the Student Contract for Distance Learners for the details on how the cooling off period works and what this means in terms of cancellation and refunds.
 - b. You are permitted to withdraw from your module at any time and for any reason after your cooling off period, but you may not be entitled to a refund of your fees for the module (unless we are in material breach of our obligations to you or are instigating a Significant Change – as described in Section 4 of the Student Contract for Distance Learners).
4. **Progression to a programme and when this Addendum stops applying:**
 - a. Unless set out in the relevant programme specification(s) and/or module descriptor(s), the University does not promise that the credit gained from a standalone module can be used to progress to a specific programme, qualification or award, beyond the standalone module you have purchased.
 - b. If you are permitted by the University and would like to use your credit from a standalone module(s) towards a programme, this Addendum will stop applying to you when you accept an offer of a place for that programme and transfer any credit you have earned (and the main Student Contract for Distance Learners will continue to apply to you).
